

How to Construct a Bibliography

- * A Bibliography or Reference List is organised in alphabetical/numerical order by the first letter/number of each reference entry.
- * This is usually the first letter of the author's surname, but not always, as you will see in the example below.
- * If your entry is long and needs to move to another line on the page, you must use a hanging indent in the 2nd and following lines.
